Report from QSEC

As we approach 2 years of operation we considered it timely to review our procedures taking into consideration feedback from our hirers, event organisers and the public. We draw your attention to the following QSEC policies: A trial will be conducted over the next few months that allows bedding to be left in stables at the conclusion of an event. Stables must be left clean of manure, hay and wet bedding. All dry bedding must be pushed back to the walls to allow the floor to dry. As defined in the QSEC Terms and Conditions of Hire all baling twine etc. must be removed from the stables along with any other foreign materials; bonds will be retained should stables not be left in a clean state and damage will continue to be charged to the Event Organiser. Should any hazardous materials be left in the stables (e.g. sharps) the trial will be immediately discontinued.


We will be introducing a bond for the QSEC camping area. This will be refundable providing that all rubbish, dog and horse manure and hay is appropriately disposed of following an event. As QSEC is a strictly no glass venue, any glass found in the camping area will result in the retention of the bond.

The event organisers are responsible for any rubbish that is left around the grounds including the camping, stables and Main Arena. We will provide fresh bins and it will be the hirer's responsibility to swap these with any full bins. The full bins will need to be left along the internal roadway for rubbish collection at the end of your event (please check if you are unsure on this location). The cleaning bond will be retained if rubbish is left around the venue.

Day Parking will no longer be available at the Main Arena. All competitor parking, including day and over night, will be at the Stables or Outdoor Arena Complex, both accessed via Old Gympie Road.

We appreciate your support of the venue and your assistance in maintaining the facilities during a busy equestrian season. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding the above.
